

Methodology



Method

Online survey among respondents 18 years of age or older.

(U.S. sample: n= 1,001).

Respondents were randomly recruited using LEO's online panel.



When

November 24 to November 27, 2023



Margin of error

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size yields a margin of error no greater than ±3.1% (19 times out of 20).



Weighting

Results were weighted according to age, gender, region, education, ethnicity, and number of people in the household in order to ensure a representative sample of the American population.



Methodology



Significant differences

Data in bold **red** characters indicate a significantly lower proportion than that of other respondents. Conversely, data in bold **green** characters indicate a significantly higher proportion that that of other respondents.



Rounded data

The numbers presented have been rounded up. However, the numbers before rounding were used to calculate the sums presented and might therefore not correspond to the manual addition of these numbers.

Key Highlights

Every month, we conduct a survey of Canadians and U.S. residents to explore their views on the economy, finances, and their respective governments. This month, our survey was conducted between November 24 and 26, 2023.

Some of the key highlights of our survey about the economy and American politics include...

Economic concerns continue

- More than half (55%) of U.S. residents think the United States is currently in a recession.
- Three-in-ten (30%) U.S. residents describe their household's finances as poor (22%) or very poor (8%).
- Almost half of U.S. residents (47%) say they are living paycheck to paycheck.
- More than a third of U.S. residents (36%) who are currently employed are concerned about losing their job in the next 12 months.

Trump continues to receive high support from Republican voters

- If the Presidential election were to be held today, there would be a small gap between Joe Biden (44%) and Donald Trump (42%).
- Donald Trump is the preferred Republican candidate for president in 2024, receiving the support of more than half (56%) of Republican voters.
- More than half of Americans disapprove of Joe Biden's job as president (55%), while a third approve (35%).



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




State of Household Finances - Trended






Living Paycheck to Paycheck - Trended






Economic Recession in the Country - Trended






Concerns About Losing Job (1/3)




Concerns About Losing Job – *Trended*

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


Preferred Republican Candidate






Biden's Approval Rating (1/2)


